

Magic Set Editor



I used the [Magic Set Editor](https://magicseteditor.sourceforge.net) (MSE) magicseteditor.sourceforge.net to create the card set "Big Al's Cards". I began on November 11, 2009 and the set was play tested on December 8, 2011. I just now remembered! My set does have a name! it is MTG: Sexy. The bright pink lady to the left is the set symbol if it was big enough to see. The MSE automatically converts your set symbol to black, sliver and gold on the cards.

UPDATE: Magic Set Editor has a new site - <https://magicseteditor.boards.net/> Current version 2.0.1.

I started with version 0.3.7b. I finished with 2.0.0. One of the big changes is in version 2, rule text fills in automatically. So if you type in Defender, you get Defender (*Creatures with defender can't attack.*). Pretty handy.
